# MOUNT RUSHMORE, THE BADLANDS, & BLACK HILLS OF SOUTH DAKOTA & YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

### 10 Days - 9 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 Depart from Missouri aboard your motorcoach and travel to the legendary Black Hills of South Dakota. Along the way, you will check into your overnight hotel. Enjoy dinner on your own in the area.
- Day 2 This morning you will enjoy a Continental Breakfast at the hotel, then check out and depart for a visit to the spectacular Badlands National Park. Afterwards, you will arrive at the amazing Wall Drug Store for a visit. Dinner and lodging in the area have been arranged for you this evening.
- Day 3 Start the day with a Continental Breakfast before heading to the Borglum Historical Center, where you will learn the story of Gutzon Borglum, the sculptor of Mount Rushmore. Then enjoy a tour of Wildlife Loop Road at Custer State Park. The Wildlife Loop Road takes you through rolling prairies and pine-covered hills, offering one of the best spots in the region to view native animals in the wild. This evening, enjoy dinner and entertainment at a popular restaurant in the area.
- Day 4 After enjoying Breakfast, you will depart for the High Plains Western Heritage Center. Then, you'll head for Deadwood, SD, the former home of Wild Bill Hickok and Calamity Jane now the location of gaming establishments in beautifully restored historic hotels and saloons. Enjoy a Guided Tour of Deadwood, have some gaming excitement and later, enjoy a delicious dinner.
- Day 5 After a Continental Breakfast, your tour takes you to the unique Journey Museum, which tells the complete history of the mystical Black Hills. Then, prepare for an inspirational sight at the magnificent and spectacular Crazy Horse Memorial, destined to be the world's largest memorial upon completion. You'll also learn about the sculptor Korczak Ziolkowski, his vision, and the loving family who continues his life's work. Dinner and entertainment will end your day.
- Day 6 Enjoy a Continental Breakfast before checking out and departing for a visit to the Devil's Tower National Monument. See the national monument and enjoy the visitor center, which contains interpretive exhibits, as well as the Devils Tower Natural History book store and souvenir shop. Later that day, after a relaxing dinner, you'll check into your en route hotel for a two night stay.
- Day 7 After Continental Breakfast, you'll depart for a Guided Tour of the Yellowstone National Park. See amazing sights such as the Mammoth Hot Springs and Old Faithful. Later, enjoy dinner and return to your hotel for a good night's rest
- Day 8 Following a Continental Breakfast, you will depart for the Trail End Historic Site in Sheridan, WY. The home tells the amazing story of John Kendrick, one of Wyoming's legendary success stories, who went from being a penniless cowboy to become a United States Senator. Later that day, after a relaxing dinner, you'll check into your en route hotel.
- **Day 9** Enjoy a Continental Breakfast, then check out and visit the famous **Corn Palace**. Later, continue to your en route hotel for check-in and a relaxing evening; dinner is on your own this evening.
